Degree/Program: Associate of Applied Science in Nursing

Target Institution: University of Cincinnati / College of Nursing
Degree/Program: Bachelor of Science in Nursing – RN to BSN Online

Introduction: This agreement details the applicability of courses from the Clark State Community College Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree program in the UC College of Nursing. As a public institution governed by the Ohio Department of Higher Education, UC complies with the Ohio Transfer Module (OTM) and the Transfer Assurance Guides (TAGs). Students who complete the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree at Clark State Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Clark State Community College who have followed and completed the prescribed program and are accepted into the College of Nursing will receive applicable transfer credit towards the RN to BSN Program as outlined in the charts below.

Prerequisites Requirements:

Most students will have completed the majority of the pre-requisite requirements in their associate degree program. If not all pre-requisites are complete a student may be admitted to begin the RN to BSN program immediately; however, successful completion of all pre-requisite courses is required to obtain the BSN degree. Completion of pre-requisites while enrolled in the RN to BSN program may prolong the time to degree. Not all pre-requisites are offered at the University of Cincinnati at all times in an online format. The pre-requisite courses can be completed at any regionally accredited institution and transferred to the University of Cincinnati to fulfill the requirement.

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Admission Criteria:

Please note: completing the RN degree program and the prerequisite courses in the chart above does not guarantee admission to the UC Bachelor of Science in Nursing program.

The RN to BSN program is designed for individuals who have previously completed an associate degree or diploma in nursing and are licensed registered nurses. Complete admission requirements include:

- A completed University of Cincinnati application for undergraduate admission
- All official transcripts from previous colleges attended with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Documented completion of an associate degree in nursing or diploma leading to a RN license
- Documentation of an active, unrestricted RN license
- Application fee
- Confirmation fee (once accepted)

Minimum GPA: 2.5

Admission Period: Clark State Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Nursing during the duration of this agreement, i.e. between July 2018 and July 2021.


EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:


