



Social Work Transfer Program Clark State and Capital University

Students who complete an Associate of Applied Science degree in Social Services Technology at Clark State Community College may transfer into the Social Work program at Capital University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AAS degree requirements.

Additional Information

- Course transfer requires a grade of D or better for students who complete an associate degree. A grade of a C- or better is required for students who do not complete an associate degree
- Students must earn at least a "C" in Intro to Sociology, Intro to Psychology and Lifespan Human Growth & Development

Capital University Graduation Requirements

- Students must earn at least a "C" in all Social Work classes, Social Science Statistics and Social Science Research Methods
- Students are required to complete a total of 124 semester hours
- To satisfy Capital University's residency requirement a student must complete 30 of the final 36 credit hours at Capital.

Admission Requirements

- 30 semester hours (45 quarter hours) of college credit
- Minimum GPA: 2.5
- Students must complete a separate application process to the Social Work major once accepted to Capital University. References are required prior to the Social Work admissions interview.
- This program is meant to be completed through Capital's adult degree completion program. Adult degree students benefit from hybrid course offerings at a discounted tuition rate (tuition charged per credit hour).
