By filing the FAFSA, you will be considered for all aid for which you might be eligible. The FAFSA is available in October for the following financial aid year that begins with Fall semester. Be sure to list Clark State's federal school code 004852, so your application information is sent to our Financial Aid Office for review and processing.
