Earn your EMT Short-term Technical Certificate while in high school and accelerate your career before graduation!

>>> EMT SHORT-TERM TECHNICAL CERTIFICATION

The EMT Short-Term Technical Certification is a fast paced and labor intensive seven credit hour course that can be completed in one semester. The course includes 150 - 180 hours of classroom, lab and clinical / field education experience. This certification serves as a stepping stone to full paramedic certification. Students must complete specific health requirements and a criminal background check at their own expense prior to the clinical experience. Learn more about this certificate on our website!

Upon successful completion of this course, students are eligible to take the National Registry and State Certification Examination at the basic level; students must be at least 18 years old to take the state test. Those who complete the course are prepared to work in an entry-level position in ambulance services and in fire divisions statewide.

• EMT Short-term Technical Certification

- Students will complete the EMS 1100 EMT Theory and Practice course, which is seven credit hours.
- EMS 1171 Basic Life Support: CPR is a prerequisite course for EMS 1100. NOTE: EMS 1171 is not covered by the College Credit Plus Program and will be charged a self-pay course.
