- All students with declared Social Work major are automatically admitted as Pre-Social Work students.
- In order to be admitted fully as a social work major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.25.
- Students must earn a C or higher in ENG 1111, ENG 1112, SWK 1100, and SWK 2230 at Clark State.
- Students must complete the following coursework at Clark State prior to being fully admitted to the Social Work program: BIO 1410; COM 1110; ECO 1100, 2210, or 2220; ENG 1111; ENG 1112; PLS 1100; PSY 1111; SOC 1110; SWK 1100; and SWK 2230.
- Students must submit a separate application form to the Social Work program by February 1 during their second or sophomore year (while studying at Clark State).
- 120 hours minimum are required for a BA degree at Wright State.

## 1. ADMISSIONS AND DEADLINES

### *Join the Wright Path Program*

Students interested in applying to the Wright Path must submit a request for membership at [wright.edu/clarkstate](http://wright.edu/clarkstate).

High School students must be close to graduating before applying to the Wright Path, and current Clark State College students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

### *Transfer to Wright State University*

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Clark State College in order to transfer to Wright State. To be admitted into the Social Work Program at Wright State, students must earn a minimum 2.25 GPA from Clark State College.

Students must apply for admission to Wright State and the Social Work program by February 1 of the sophomore year/year two (while still studying at Clark State).

\*Note that students must apply and be admitted to the university before Social Work Program application can be approved.


