Important Information

By completing the associate degree/Ohio Transfer Module at Clark State, you will have met the requirements for the Wright State University Core. However, you will still need to complete any remaining courses required for the department within the Wright State Core. You must complete at least two designated Integrated Writing (IW) courses in the major at Wright State.

Elementary Education P-5 program admissions requirements to be met by September 1 of the third year:

- Cumulative minimum GPA of 2.8
- Submit completed program application form
- Passing scores in each of the following areas:

- One of the following reading scores:
 - ACT reading score of 22 or better
 - SAT evidence-based reading and writing score of 543 or better
 - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators reading score of 168 or better
- One of the following writing scores:
 - ACT writing score of 6 or better
 - SAT writing dimension score of 5 or better
 - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators writing score of 165 or better
- One of the following math scores:
 - ACT math score of 22 or better
 - SAT math score of 533 or better
 - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators math score of 162 or better

Clark State Community College and Wright State University have entered into an Academic Pathway for the above degree.

- An 8 semester Academic Pathway listing the courses to take at the community college and at Wright State University will be posted on the Transfer websites at each institution.
- The 8 semesters (with approximately 15 hours each semester) are divided into 4 semesters at the community college (approximately 60 hours) and 4 semesters at Wright State University (approximately 60 hours).
- The Academic Pathway lists important transfer information specific to the major at Wright State University. Examples are major specific admissions requirements, such as minimum GPA, pre-requisite courses, and application deadlines.
- The Academic Pathway lists the contact information at both institutions.
- Any variation from taking the listed courses in the specified semesters may impact a student's completion of the Academic Pathway in 8 semesters.
- Course availability is subject to enrollment capacity.

This pathway agreement is entered into on the date below, as approved by the department chairs and Provosts of each institution. Parties at both institutions agree to honor the Transfer Guide. A new Transfer Agreement will be entered into if there are any changes to the Transfer Guide.
