**I UNDERSTAND THAT:**

1. Students are enrolling in college courses that will become a part of the students' permanent college academic record. Courses taken under Option B will be included on the high school transcript and calculated in the high school grade point average. Courses taken for high school graduation credit may impact a student's ability to graduate high school and class standing. Students can choose to self-pay for tuition and costs of all textbooks, materials, and fees associated with a course under Option A at the time of enrollment. Students must notify the high school and Clark State College of the choice of Option A and the choice of receiving both the high school and college credits or college credit only. 2. Students taking College Credit Plus courses under Option B who fail, stop attending, and/or withdraw from course(s) after the 14th day of the semester may be billed by their school district for all tuition and fees associated with those courses. A student may drop a class prior to the College's no penalty drop date and Clark State College will remove the course from the student's academic record. Students who wish to drop a college class should discuss with their high school guidance counselor and Clark State College's CCP advisor before doing so.
3. Students may not register for more hours than indicated by the school counselor/principal. Students taking a course(s) causing them to exceed the maximum yearly credit hours permitted under College Credit Plus will be responsible for self-paying and will be billed by Clark State College for all tuition, books, materials, and fees associated with those courses. Unpaid balances may be referred to the Attorney General's Office for collection.
4. Male students or students with sex assigned at birth as male who turn 18 by the time of enrollment are required to provide their Selective Service number within 30 days of their 18th birthday to the Records and Registration Office. If they do not submit their Selective Service number, the student will be billed for all tuition at the out-of-state tuition rate and responsible for any fees and textbooks. This rate will be billed until the Selective Service number is provided.
5. Parents should not contact instructors regarding student progress, attendance, assignments, etc. All communication regarding the student must be handled through the College Credit Plus Office and/or the school counselor in accordance with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
6. If the student has a documented disability, it is the student's responsibility to request necessary accommodations through Clark State College's Office of Accessibility Services.
