# Clark State Community College, A.A.B-Management to Wittenberg University B.A.-Organizational Leadership

Students who complete an Associate of Applied Business degree in Management at Clark State Community College may transfer into the Organizational Leadership, Bachelor of Art degree at Wittenberg University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their Associate of Applied Business degree requirements.

Students interested in pursuing Organizational Leadership degree at Wittenberg University are encouraged to take the following courses in addition to the Associate of Applied Business degree at Clark State Community College.

#### Admission Requirements to Professional Degree Program at Wittenberg University

- 1. Cumulative GPA of 2.5 and have completed a minimum of 24 credit hours including ENG 1100 and 2100 (or equivalent) with a grade of C or higher, plus three other Transfer University Core courses from Element 3, 4, or 5.
- 2. Students can transfer up to 94 credits to Wittenberg University
- 3. All courses must have a grade of C or higher to be transferred to Wittenberg University

#### **Additional Information**

- Degree seeking students at Wittenberg must complete at least 32 semester hours of credits to earn a degree.

- This agreement will expire two years from date of signature.
