<u>Franklin University Transfer Notes</u>	
Laboratory component needed for at least 1 science course.	
For the Social Sciences requirement students must take courses in at least 2 separate disciplines.	
Both General Education and University Electives must be non-developmental.	
Students may select up to 8 credit hours of select graduate coursework for elective credit.	
Transfer credit hour minimums for a 4 hour Franklin course is 2.67 semester hours. The difference in transferred credit and Franklin course credit must be made up in the General Education Elective and/or University elective sections.
