# **WHAT TO BRING**

# To complete the 2019-2020 FAFSA (Spring 2020 and Summer 2020) students must bring:

- FSA ID (studentaid.gov)
- Student's (and spouse if married) 2017 Federal Income Tax Return
- Parent's 2017 Federal Income Tax Return (dependent students only)
- Parent's social security number, birth date, marital status and date (dependent students only)
- Amounts of any additional income received in 2017 such as child support or untaxed income such as payments to tax deferred pensions
- Permanent resident card if you are an eligible non-citizen

# To complete the 2020-2021 FAFSA (Fall 2020, Spring 2021 and Summer 2021) students must bring:

- FSA ID (studentaid.gov)
- Student's (and spouse if married) 2018 Federal Income Tax Return
- Parent's 2018 Federal Income Tax Return (dependent students only)
- Parent's social security number, birth date, marital status and date (dependent students only)
- Amounts of any additional income received in 2018 such as child support or untaxed income such as payments to tax deferred pensions
- Permanent resident card if you are an eligible non-citizen

\*Reservations are not needed; space is limited. If you do not have all of the appropriate documents, you are still welcome to attend the workshop. Staff can also assist with financial aid questions and help you navigate through the FAFSA process.
