- In order to be admitted into the RN-BSN Completion program at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0.
- Students must earn a C or higher in ENG 1111, ENG 1112, and PSY 1111 at Clark State.
- Students must possess an active RN license.
- Both BCI and FBI background checks are required for undergraduate students; the background check results must have no criminal record on file.
- Students working for Premier Health may be eligible for annual tuition assistance from Premier Health, as well as a supplemental scholarship from Wright State University which covers remaining tuition costs. Contact the Human Resources Department at Premier Health about tuition assistance eligibility.
- In addition, request to meet with Wright State's program advisor to learn about additional scholarships at nursing@wright.edu.
- 120-122 hours minimum are required for a BSN degree at Wright State.

Students may complete the following remaining coursework outside nursing either at Clark State or Wright State prior to or after transferring to Wright State. If students decide to complete the remaining coursework, they are strongly encouraged to complete the entire Ohio Transfer 36 requirement for Clark State.
