Earn your Nurse Aide Short-Term Technical Certificate while in high school and accelerate your career before graduation!

>>> NURSE AIDE SHORT-TERM TECHNICAL CERTIFICATE

The Nurse Aide Short-Term Technical Certificate is an 84 hour course that introduces students to the principles and procedures of basic patient care for a variety of individuals. The course is regulated by the Ohio Department of Health and 100% attendance is required. Students must complete specific health requirements and a criminal background check at their own expense prior to the clinical experience. Learn more about this certificate on our website!

After completing the lecture, skills lab and clinical components of this certification, students will be prepared for entry-level employment in long term care, home healthcare, hospice, hospital setting(s) and many free-standing clinics. Students will receive a certificate of completion which will allow them to take the Ohio Nurse Aide state test; students must be at least 18 years old to take the state test. After passing both the written and skills components of the exam, the student will be placed on the Ohio Nurse Aide Registry.

• Students will complete the MST 1181 Nurse Aide Training Nurse Aide Training course, which is four credit hours.
